I suoi principali progetti si svolgono in Pakistan, Etiopia e Colombia. È autore di numerosi articoli pubblicati su riviste come il Journal of Financial Economics, la Review of Financial Studies e The Economic Journal.

Ha conseguito il Dottorato in Economics presso la London School of Economics and Political Science nel 2017 e una Laurea Triennale e Magistrale in Economia presso l'Università di Pisa e la Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna.
