

TUITION WAIVER FOR INTERNATIONAL CANDIDATES

SDA Bocconi School of Management is making available three partial merit-based tuition waivers of up to EUR **12,600** (30% of the tuition fee) to outstanding international candidates to the **21st edition (a.y. 2026-27)** of EMMS.

1. Beneficiaries and Requirements

In order to be eligible for a tuition waiver, students must demonstrate superior academic achievements, proven professional acumen, a determination to influence the future of business, and must meet the following requirements:

- They are **international** (non-Italian/non-Spanish) **candidates**. Candidates are considered international based on the nationality indicated in their passport. Candidates holding dual nationality are eligible provided that at least one of their nationalities is neither Italian nor Spanish.
- They have not received any financial support that, if combined with the SDA Bocconi tuition waiver, would be in excess of the total tuition fee (scholarships or sponsorships)
- They meet all admissions requirements for participation in the **EMMS 21st Edition**.

Only candidates who have applied within the deadlines, producing all required documentation, and have been admitted to the **21st edition (a.y. 2026-27)** of EMMS, are eligible for a tuition waiver.

2. Compatibility with other fee reductions and financial support

The tuition waiver cannot be combined with the Early Bird Fee.

Admitted candidates who, having completed their formal enrollment by **10th November 2026**, have been granted the Early Bird Fee, are still eligible for a partial Tuition Waiver. However, if they are awarded a partial Tuition Waiver, they lose any right to the Early Bird Fee. Their payment guidelines are updated accordingly.

Admitted candidates who have not completed their formal enrollment by **10th November 2026** are not eligible for the Early Bird Fee, but they are still eligible for the partial Tuition Waiver.

The waiver can be combined with any other scholarship, award, or financial support for specialization courses by public or private organizations or companies only if the total amount does not exceed the total registration fee. Beneficiaries must self-certify that the above-mentioned cumulation has not been exceeded. Beneficiaries must comply with this condition for the whole duration of the EMMS Program.

The right to the tuition waiver is subject to the regular completion of the EMMS Program as indicated in the **EMMS 21st Edition (a.y. 2026-27)** Rules.

3. Lodging of Applications and Results

Applications for the tuition waiver, together with a Motivational Letter, must be sent through the online Application portal in accordance with the deadlines indicated in the table below.

The assignment of the tuition waiver will be formally notified to the beneficiary by the Commission through an assignment letter, no later than the Communication of award dates indicated in the table below.

4. Acceptance of the conditions

Application for the tuition waiver involves full acceptance of the herein conditions. Under penalty of immediate withdrawal, candidates must confirm their enrolment in the **21st Edition (a.y. 2026-27)** of EMMS as well as formalize their acceptance of all tuition waiver conditions with the Admissions office by the deadline indicated on the tuition waiver assignment letter.
